COMMCON 4 UPDATE

The fourth semi-annual CommCon was held February 23rd. Attendees received updates from the Sergeant Bluff-Luton Community School District and the City. Updates related to City developments include:

- New council members Jim Linafelter and Carol Clark were recognized as well as Nicole Cleveland, who was recently re-elected, and current members Ron Hanson and Bill Gaukel.
- Special thanks was given to Dave Woodford and Deb Huser for their service to the community as past council members.
- The City's tax levy on your property taxes will go down in the coming year from \$12.81 to \$12.60 per thousand.
- Jefferson Park will have some upcoming renovations to the tennis courts.
- New walkway segments: 1) South side of First Street from Roundtable/Windsor Way to Dollar General. 2) South Lewis Boulevard from Fareway/First Street to the Rec Complex.
- The major construction of the Senior Center located near the Community Center is complete and ready to transition into normal operations.
- Streets: Repairs are slated to occur in the Oak Hills and Camelot subdivisions this year. Pioneer Valley Drive will be hard surfaced as well.
- The First Street corridor is planned to be improved to include brick landscaping and other features.
- Permanent stoplights at the I-29 interchange will be designed and bid in July with estimated completion in the Spring of 2017.
- The Council is planning for a 1-1.5 MW solar project, to be located on the Water Plant property, as a renewable fuel power source for our community.
- Update to existing Economic Development and other City projects.
