LARGE VEHICLE PARKING

City Ordinance states that no person shall park or leave standing a motor truck, semi-trailer, or other motor vehicle with trailer attached in any street or alley of the Residential Districts of the City if the vehicle weights five tons or more (69.09). KEEP IT TRIMMED

Please do your part as a good neighbor and cut your grass. If you will be out of town, please arrange for someone to maintain your yard. City ordinance requires every property owner to cut, mow, and maintain all grass and yard debris upon the owner's property. In addition, no grass dumping is allowed. It shall be presumed that a health, fire, or safety hazard exists when weeds or grass is in excess of twelve (12) inches in length. If your lawn length exceeds 12 inches, the City will be contacting you.

JUST A SMALL LEAK?

A small leak can result in a big bill. If you discover a leak in your home it is in your best interest to have it repaired. A continuous leak at 60 pounds per square inch (psi) from a hole the size illustrated below over a three month period would result in water being wasted in the amounts shown below:
