

# Semiannual Free Cleanup Week



**It is time for Fall Cleanup!** The City of Sergeant Bluff offers a semi-annual cleanup week in the Spring & Fall. This is NOT curbside pickup. All items must be taken to the City compost site during open hours of operation. During this week only, dumping is free of charge and is for Ser-

geant Bluff residents only (see Important Change at right). Items that CANNOT be dumped include: Batteries, paint, broken concrete, asphalt, used oil, bricks, tires, recyclable goods, fluorescent light bulbs, treated lumber (with creosote, such as railroad ties), gas and oil filters and containers, solvents or cleaners. Lawn/yard waste can be dumped at the compost site but must be separated from all other items. There is never a charge to dump lawn/yard waste.

You may bring white goods, such as washers, dryers and hot water heaters, to the compost site during any regular compost site hours. There will always be a

\$10 charge per appliance for demanufacturing. You **must purchase a ticket** for each appliance at City Hall, prior to taking the item(s) to the compost site.

Please call City Hall if you have specific questions about the semi-annual cleanup week.

## HOURS OF OPERATION:

During cleanup week, the compost site will be open 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. Monday through Friday & on Saturday from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

## Important Change:

Because cleanup week is for **SERGEANT BLUFF RESIDENTS** only, we are now requiring anyone who is planning to dump to show **proof of Sergeant Bluff residency**. Acceptable forms of proof are a drivers license showing a Sergeant Bluff address or a City of Sergeant Bluff utility bill. Please understand that this minor inconvenience will allow us to continue offering this service. Thank you for your understanding.

*Please remember that it is illegal to dump at the compost site when it is not open and manned by City personnel.*
