IMPROVEMENTS TO YOUR RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL PROPERTY

DID YOU KNOW YOU MAY NEED A PERMIT FROM THE CITY FIRST?

A building permit must be obtained for the work described in this section and fees must be paid, or arrangements made for payment, in accordance with the permit fee schedules prior to commencement of the work.

- ✚ New buildings
- ✚ Addition/Remodel to home or other structure on property
- ✚ Plumbing Work
- ✚ Electrical Work
- ✚ Furnace/HVAC (New/Replacements)
- ✚ Fencing (New or Replacement)
- ✚ Decks
- ✚ Concrete Work (ie... driveways, sidewalks...) for new or replacements
- ✚ Signs (ie... commercial signage)
- ✚ Demolition of any structure greater than 150 square feet
- ✚ Roofing (if replacing decking)
- ✚ Accessories (ie...swimming pool, storage shed exceeding 150 sq. ft., detached garage...)

Except in emergency situations, as determined by the Building Inspector, where work for which a building permit is required by Chapter 156 of the City of Sergeant Bluff Code of Ordinances is started or proceeded with prior to obtaining a permit, the regular fees for such work as specified therein shall be **doubled**. The payment of such doubled fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of Chapter 156 in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed therein.
