ELECTRONIC RECYCLING EVENT

The City of Sergeant Bluff is sponsoring an electronics recycling event on Saturday, April 13th between 8 am and 12-noon next to the Community Center. They will take all sorts of electronic items, which includes anything with a circuit board in it. They will not take books or paper. Cash or check is acceptable.

- Small TV/15 inch or Monitor: \$15.00
- Medium TV/up to 25 inches: \$20.00
- Large TV/up to 30 inches: \$30.00
- Console TV/Projection TV: \$35.00
- Big printers/copies: \$25.00
- Small printers/microwaves: \$5.00

WHEN IT RAINS IT DRAINS

Storm Water will transport pollutants carelessly left or intentionally placed in or near a storm drain into water bodies used for drinking water, swimming, or fishing.

- * Never dump anything down storm drains.
- * Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks and roads.
- * Never mow or sweep grass clippings onto the street.
- * Don't hose down driveways (either sweep up or blowback into the yard).
- * Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces.
- * Take your vehicle to the car wash or wash it on the grass.
- * Check car for leaks and recycle motor oil.
- * Pick up after your pet.
- * Seed bare spots in your lawn.
- * Use a compost pile or yard waste collection bin.
