PAY YOUR UTILITY BILL THROUGH PSN

The City of Sergeant Bluff will no longer take credit card payments **over the phone**, however you can still pay using your credit card in-person or by making your payment through Payment Service Network. If you like to pay over the phone, you can still do so by calling PSN at 1-877-885-7968, be sure to have your Utility account number ready.

You can also register (optional) with Payment Service Network to have your bill paid directly out of your checking account each month. By doing this you can substantially save money over the course of time.

EXAMPLE CREDIT CARD PAYMENT YEARLY COST

HYPOTHETICAL UTILITY BILL: \$200.00 per month

CREDIT CARD FEE: \$5.50 x 12 months = **\$66.00**

PARKING DURING A SNOW EMERGENCY

With the snow season upon us, we would like to remind everyone of the snow ordinances as it relates to parking. Ordinance 69.10 (1) states that: "No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or city owned off-street parking within 48 hours after a snow fall of 2 inches or more."

Ordinance 69.10 (2) deals with larger snow events. When major storms are foreseen the City may declare a snow emergency which requires all vehicles to be removed from the street immediately. The snow emergency remains in effect until the streets have been cleared following the snow event.

Enforcement action will remain for both sections until the streets have been cleared from curb to curb. Please allow crews to clear snow from curb to curb before parking on the street. You must wait until the crews have had time to come back and clear the street completely, this may take multiple passes.

Temporarily parking in your yard or other areas of your property during the snow event will be allowed during the snow events. The police department and city snow removal crew's thank you in advance for your cooperation. Help us keep our streets clear and safe through the snow season.

ATV ORDINANCE

The City Council has passed ordinance 695 which changes the hours for which a City-registered ATV may be operated within City limits. Effective December 6th a City-registered ATV may be driven on City roads between sunrise to sunset.

Applications to register your ATV with the City are available at City Hall. You will need to provide your DNR ATV Permit, proof of insurance, proof of registration and a Drivers license. Fees are:

\$25.00/1 yr, \$45/2 yr, \$65.00/3 yr.
