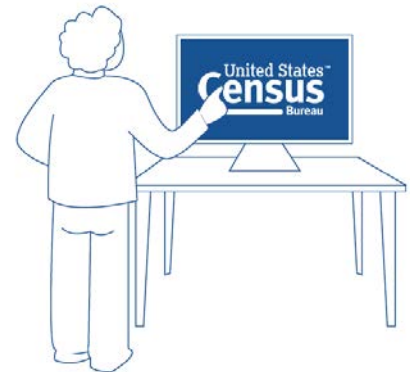

SERGEANT BLUFF COUNTS!

Beginning mid-March the 2020 Census will begin mailing out notifications of your ability to complete the 2020 Census online. The city library located at 903 Topaz Drive will be available during regular library hours for those without a computer or internet access. Each decade, census results determine how many seats your state gets in Congress and influence funding for community services for the next 10 years. Data from the census helps determine where more than \$675 billion is spent each year in states and communities. That includes money for things like:

- Housing and food assistance
- Libraries and community centers
- First responders, like firefighters and police departments
- Medicare and Medicaid
- Hospitals and schools
- Roads and public works

Bring your vehicle license plate number!

FEES FOR THE COMPOST SITE:

- Yard waste: Free with annual pass
- Car Trunk Load: \$10.00
- Pickup/Single Axle Trailer: \$25.00
- Large Truck/Multiple Axle: \$65.00
- Appliances/White Goods: \$15.00
- *Tickets can only be purchased at City Hall
