## FIREWORKS REMINDER

The City of Sergeant Bluff permits the discharge of consumer grade fireworks three days prior to July 4<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 4:30 PM until 10:00 pm and up until midnight on July 4<sup>th</sup>. It is the responsibility of every resident who participates in the discharge of fireworks to ensure that they are in compliance with the law. ## MAINTAINING YOUR EASEMENT

We'd like to remind residents that Ordinances 52.03 & 52.06 instruct property owners to cut, mow and maintain all grass, weeds, brush, vegetation, and noxious weeds upon your property, the easement, and any area adjacent to the curb line or outer boundary of any street, including the parking area.
