

Biking Bus Information

- Bikers should pre register each day to get on the Bike Bus by registering at <https://cityofsergeantbluff.com/2020/06/summerinthebluff/>
- All bikers are required to wear a bike helmet.
- The route is about 10 miles long in total and should be out on the route for about an hour and thirty minutes from the time the biking bus picks them up.
- The Biking Bus will run Tuesday & Thursday mornings. Staff will leave the Rec Complex at 9:25am and pick kids up along the route and drop them off the staff's second time around the route. Course route and approximate times through areas is posted on the city's website.
- The biking bus will not run during in climate weather. An announcement will be made via the City Webpage.
- The bike ride is open to all ages and we encourage parents to join us.
- Each rider is encouraged to bring a water along
- There will be 3 designated stops to have a quick break—Primary Parking Lot, Splash Pad & Recreation Complex. Each stop kids will be allowed to get a drink and there will be a discussion on bicycle safety.
- The ride will be staffed by 3 people—Lead, Trail and Rover
