If the animal leaves your property, you must accompany the animal and have control of it on a leash, cord, chain or similar restraint.

DO YOU HAVE MORE THAN FIVE TOTAL PETS?

City ordinance 55.21 allows for pet owners to maintain up to five (5) animals that are older than four months, this means no more than three (3) dogs or five (5) cats, but the combination shall not exceed five (5) total animals. However, you may apply for an Avocation Permit for additional animals (limitations apply). All residents within the City Limits must apply for an Avocation Permit if they are over the current limit, this also applies to Pet Rescue and Foster Care homes. An Avocation Permit may be applied for at City hall. An inspection and annual renewal of the application is required (fees apply). Please see Ordinance 55.21 for additional details.
