## GARBAGE CART REMINDER

Every utility customer is responsible for the garbage cart assigned to their property. If a garbage cart becomes lost due to weather or other circumstances, the customer is responsible for paying for the replacement cost charged by Gill Hauling which is \$100.00. Please make an effort to locate your cart after a storm. Garbage carts are often picked up by helpful neighbors in an attempt to keep the cart from being damaged in the street. You are always welcome to call City Hall to confirm that you have the correct cart, which has a unique serial number at 712-943-4244.

## LEASHED ANIMALS

We would like to remind residents that animals are not allowed to run at large within the corporate limits of the City (Ord. 55.06). Every animal must remain on your property and/or held firmly on a leash on your property. If the animal leaves your property, you must accompany the animal and have control of it on a leash, cord, chain or similar restraint.

## SEWER RATE INCREASE

As a result of increased charges that the City of Sergeant Bluff is receiving from the City of Sioux City for sewer treatment, it has become necessary to increase our sewer rates. The minimum service charge will increase from \$8.55 per month to \$9.58 and the usage charge will increase from \$8.84 to \$9.90 for each 1,000 gallons of water used per month. This new rate will be effective on the utility bill that is sent at the beginning of August.
