APPROVE AGENDA

REVENUE & EXPENDITURE REPORT

No big changes. Just bought some minor equipment for the Rec Center.

OPEN DISCUSSION (No action may be taken) Please limit discussion of each item to 10 minutes.

Carol updated the board about the facility changes that were just announced this morning. The library will now be located on the East side of the new City Hall, the police station will be located at the old City Hall, and the current library will become the new Senior Center. There was some discussion about the new senior center and falling under the parks board. Jason came to this meeting to update the board on the Kiwanis Park project. The project is out for bid right now and bids are due November 3rd by 2:00pm and will be announced at the Council Meeting on November 8th.

1. Outdoor Pool

- a. Tyler and Aaron drafted a pool survey that will be sent out in the newsletters with the city bills and there will also be an option to submit the survey online.
- b. The rec center hosted a haunted house this year. It went through the pool hall and then through the IBF. There were over 600 people who went through the haunted house.

2. Sergeant Bluff Community Center

- a. Tyler updated everyone about the issues getting the volleyball sleeves put in. Also mentioned that there have been no complaints about the new floor.
- b. The rec centers pipe and drape they have for events is probably 20 years old and is no longer white so new pipe and drape has been ordered and will be shipped out next week.
- c. Mary Torgersen is now working for the rec department doing crafts for younger kids at least once a month if not more. She held an event on Sunday October 16th and had 10 kids attend. The Parks and Rec held their craft night Tuesday October 18th and had 28 kids attend.
- d. Last year the rec had a fall fest and this year they are planning to do a spooky fest to coincide with Halloween. It is on the last Sunday of the month. There will be crafts, games, snacks, costume contest, and photo op areas. That will be in the gym from 2-4 pm and right after the spooky fest is the trick-or-treat trail from 4-5pm.

3. Parks

- a. The Fire Department got a hold of Tyler and has some funds that they want to donate to the rec center for Jewel Park. They are donating a fire truck and ambulance rocker.

4. Recreation

- a. Fall sports just finished up. Volleyball went okay this year. It was difficult due to the volleyball sleeves not being in and having to use makeshift nets.
- b. Registration for youth basketball just opened and there are already 25 kids signed up. They are going to give some flyers to the schools to send home with all the kids about registration.
- c. In the past, adults would gather on Wednesdays and Sundays at the high school and play a pickup game of basketball. Instead, the rec has decided to have adult net night on Wednesdays from 7 to 10pm and have it for adults 21 and over. Ping Pong will be moved into the Fireside room on Wednesdays and stay in the gym on Sundays.
