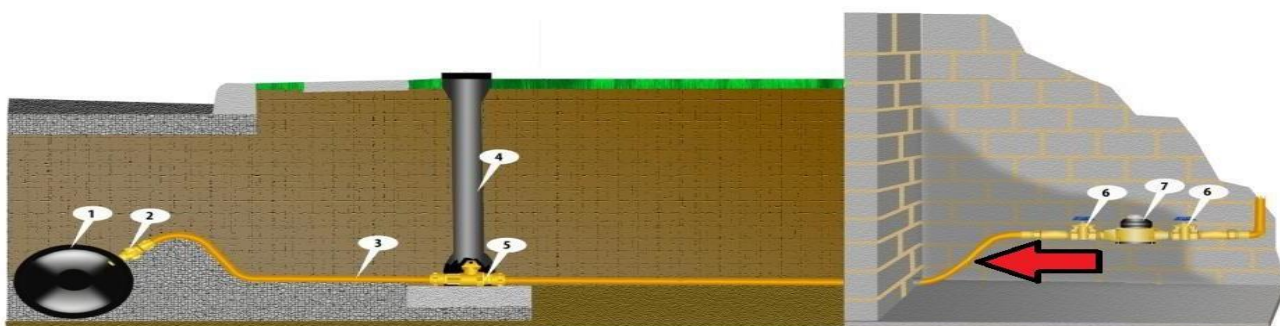

## How to Identify your water service line material:

1. **Lead**
  - a. Dark Grey in Color
  - b. Non-Magnetic
2. **Copper**
  - a. Copper in Color
  - b. If Green in Color, scratch with a coin to show if a shiny copper color appears
3. **Galvanized Steel**
  - a. Silver in Color
  - b. Magnetic
4. **Plastic (Polyethylene)**
  - a. Colors include: White, Black or Blue



1. Water Main
2. Corporation Stop (service is tapped to the main)
3. Service Line
4. Curb Box (allows access to curb-stop valve)
5. Curb-Stop Valve (usually located on/near property line)

6. House shut-off valve before meter (located in basement)
  7. Water Meter
  6. Optional valve to keep household plumbing from draining, after the meter
