COMPOST SITE – FEES & CLEANUP WEEK

The compost site will re-open in April. Free clean-up week will be April 10-15th, Residents are required to update their Compost Site Pass each year. **They will be available by mid-March. You cannot enter Compost Site without an updated 2023 pass.** Please stop by City Hall in mid-March with your old pass to complete a new form and update your pass. Bring your vehicle license plate number!

FEES FOR THE COMPOST SITE:

- Yard waste: Free with annual pass
 - Car Load/Pickup/Single Axle Trailer: \$20.00
 - Large Truck/Multiple Axle: \$65.00
 - Appliances/White Goods: \$15.00
- *Tickets can only be purchased at City Hall

CALL BEFORE YOU DIG

Whether you're trenching in a field, planting a tree, or digging a foundation, Iowa law requires everyone to locate underground utilities before digging. First, notify Iowa One Call to begin the process, then wait 48 hours (excluding Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays) BEFORE any digging begins. Call 811 before you dig. This service is FREE and it's the law!



DO YOU NEED A PERMIT?

Permits are required for many building projects, such as installing a fence, driveway, or sidewalk, doing plumbing or electrical work, installing a new furnace/HVAC, putting on a deck, demolition of structures, and more.
