TREE LIMBS OVER SIDEWALKS

Did you know that a tree limb that overhangs a sidewalk must be at least eight (8) feet above the sidewalk? (Ord 151.03) It is the responsibility of the property owner to maintain the tree limb height. By adhering to this ordinance you are helping to preserve a walkable community.

Persons desiring to request information from or register complaints with CITY OF SERGEANT BLUFF CONCERNING ELECTRICITY SERVICE may do so by contacting:

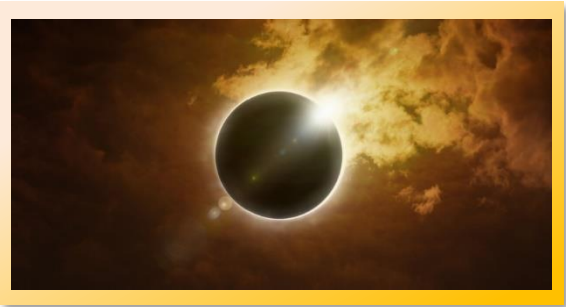

Candidacy paperwork may be picked up from City Hall, and filed with the City Clerk's Office at City Hall. There are currently two Council Member positions that are up for election. The election will be held on November 7th.

NOISE ORDINANCE(S)

The City of Sergeant Bluff has two relevant noise ordinances that you should be aware of. It is prohibited to make loud or raucous noises that cause unreasonable distress to the occupants of residences or public buildings in the vicinity (Ord 40.03). It is also prohibited for a dog owner to allow their dog to cause serious annoyance or disturbance by frequent and habitual barking or howling (Ord 55.08).

KEEP OUR COMMUNITY CLEAN

Please help to keep our community clean, don't litter. Make the effort to place your trash in the nearest trash can. Don't throw trash from your vehicle onto the streets or roadways. Keep a plastic bag in your vehicle to place garbage in until you have an opportunity to properly discard it. When you visit a park, remember to take out what you bring in. Thank you for your help!
