COMPOST SITE – FEES & CLEANUP WEEK

The compost site will re-open in **April**. Residents are required to obtain a new annual Compost Site Pass each year. **You cannot use last year's pass and you cannot enter the Compost Site without one.** Please stop by City Hall to complete a new form and pick up your 2019 Annual Pass. Bring your vehicle license plate number!

 - Car Trunk Load: \$10.00
 - Pickup/Single Axle Trailer: \$25.00
 - Large Truck/Multiple Axle: \$65.00
 - Appliances/White Goods: \$15.00

HOUSE NUMBERS TO AID THE CENSUS

With the upcoming 2020 Census beginning early next year, we would like to remind residents of the importance of having a house number that is easily visible from the road. We would like to ensure that our community is accurately counted and that federal census workers are able to locate everyone in our community. Census statistics are utilized in federal and state funding for things like educational programs, healthcare, law enforcement and highways among other things.

In addition, City Ordinance requires that you maintain your house number in a conspicuous place that is at least 2 ½ inches in height and exhibits a high contrast with the color of your home. (Ord 150.02). It is also recommended that they are large enough to be seen by someone approaching at a reasonable distance and are displayed in numerical digits rather than written (cursive) form.
